The QPR Institute, Inc. is a self-sustaining educational and training organization registered as a corporation in the State of Washington, USA. It is an independently-owned company with the single mission of suicide prevention education and training. It does not provide clinical services, crisis response, supervision or consultation for crisis or mental health service providers.

### **Affiliations**

The QPR Institute is not affiliated with any organization except by written contract or partnership agreement.

The QPR Institute does not sanction or approve the work or services rendered by those persons or organizations that earn certificates or complete training programs offered by the Institute.

### **Supervision**

The QPR Institute and its faculty, including those holding certificates as Certified QPR Gatekeeper Instructors or Advanced Clinical Instructors, do not offer or provide clinical supervision to those learners enrolled in our online or classroom courses.

The term “supervision” implies a special relationship between a volunteer or employee in which the supervisor is responsible in whole or in part for the work and delivery of service the person supervised. QPR Institute instructors and trainers teach content and skills, but do not provide current, case-specific, or ongoing supervision to those they train.

### **Competency**

All online and classroom courses are designed to meet the minimum requirements for the knowledge and skill goals and objectives defined by a given training program or course.

Earning a certificate from any QPR Institute course does not imply practice competence in the settings in which the person is employed or volunteers, but only that the person demonstrated knowledge and skills taught in the course and as determined by passing knowledge content exams and/or standardized practice challenges through guided role-play.

### **Qualifications of learners**

The QPR Institute does not screen, qualify, or vet persons who enroll in its training programs either online or in classroom settings. If the learner volunteers or is employed by an organization, it is the organization’s responsibility to determine fitness and suitability for training.
